

**Lj-V (Vertical) Model**



### Life jacket adjustment

Open the collar of the life jacket very wide to be able to drag the client's head while avoiding to touch his face.



**1** Adjust the strap of the belt at the waist. (in the hollow of the back and the navel)

**2** Adjust the harness securely. Place it back for man and center for women.



**3** Buckle the bottom of the front of the life jacket to the belt size.



**4** These two adjustments back straps allow you to change the angle of the legs, for clients with hypotonic lower body. For a maximum comfort. Tighten evenly backward and forward.

### Care instructions

Humidity, chlorine and the sun reduces the life of the life jacket. Store in a dry and well ventilated place, accessible at all times. If necessary, wash with mild soap. Avoid opening the zipper or take out the foam of its case; it may damage the equipment.

### Efficiency test

Tilt the collar and the recipient so that the loop under the chin touches the water. Then release the tension.

Tilt the collar and the recipient so that the side of his face touches the water. Then release the tension.

Following the release of tension, in all cases, the life jacket puts the recipient in the vertical position.

Make sure the life jacket is centered on the client's body. In the event that you find that the shoulders are out of the water, it may be that the life jacket too fleet for the weight of the recipient.



In the event that one shoulder is out of the water and if it is not because the jacket too fleet, it's probably because the client leans the head on the side. It is then possible to add a collar that will keep the head up.

This collar is also effective in cases of pendulum swing or large spasms. Standard equipment.
